To Whom It May Concern:

Texas Gas Transmission, LLC is submitting this Hydrostatic Test Notice of Intent (HTNOI) requesting authorization for a discharge of hydrostatic test water from their 36-inch-diameter pipeline in DeSoto County, Mississippi. The volume of water for the hydrostatic test at Outfall 001 will be approximately 116,500 gallons from a nearby fire hydrant and discharged onto their existing right-of-way. The volume of water for the hydrostatic test at Outfall 002 will be approximately 550,000 gallons from a private pond and discharged onto their existing right-of-way. All water will be discharged at a rate of approximately 500 gallons-per-minute into a haybale structure after being ran through a carbon filter system.

Please find attached a site location map showing the discharge locations (**Figure 1**) and the HTNOI general permit forms and requisite supporting information (**Attachment A**). The Mississippi Secretary of State Certificate of Good Standing is included as **Attachment B**. The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality approved hydrostatic surface water withdrawal requests are in **Attachment C**. 

HYDROSTATIC TEST NOTICE OF INTENT (HTNOI)

FOR COVERAGE UNDER MISSISSIPPI'S HYDROSTATIC TEST GENERAL PERMIT GENERAL PERMIT MSG13 MSG130648

(Number to be assigned by MDEQ)

INSTRUCTIONS

The Hydrostatic Test Notice of Intent (HTNOI) is for coverage under the Hydrostatic Test General Permit to discharge hydrostatic test water. Applicant must be the owner or operator. The coverage recipient is responsible for compliance with the conditions of the general permit.

Completed HTNOIs should be filed at least thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of regulated activity. <u>Discharge of hydrostatic test</u> water without written notification of coverage is a violation of state law.

If the company seeking coverage is a corporation, a limited liability company, a partnership, or a business trust, attach proof of its registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State and /or its Certificate of Good Standing. This registration or Certificate of Good Standing must be dated within twelve (12) months of the date of the submittal of this coverage form. Coverage will be issued in the company name as it is registered with the Mississippi Secretary of State.

IF REGULATED LAND DISTURBING ACTIVITIES ARE TO OCCUR, LIST ACRES DISTURBED:

NOTE: If disturbing five (5) acres or more, a stormwater construction coverage is required.

A USGS quadrangle map or copy is a required submittal. The map shall extend at least one-half of a mile beyond the facility/project property boundary. In the case of linear pipeline projects the map shall extend at least one-half of a mile beyond the pipeline right-of-way. The site location and outfalls must be outlined and labeled. Quad maps can be obtained from the Office of Geology (601-961-5523). If a copy is submitted, provide the name of the quadrangle map that is found in upper right hand corner.

Additional submittals may include the following:

- Labeled site drawing noting the outfall(s) associated with hydrostatic test water discharge(s)
- List of chemical Additives,
- Appropriate Section 404 documentation from U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, or
- Written authorization from the MDEQ, Office of Land and Water, if water withdrawal from surface waters or ground waters is to be used for the testing. For information call the Office of Land and Water at 601/961-5202

This letter will serve as authorization from the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) for Texas Gas Transmission, LLC to withdraw surface water from a stormwater retention pond, which drains into an unnamed ditch, which drains into King's View Lake, for the purpose of hydrostatic testing in Desoto County, Mississippi, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The withdrawal point shall be limited to the stormwater retention pond at approximately 34.958097°N, -90.092353°W.
- 2. The withdrawal shall be limited to a maximum pumping rate of **500 gpm**. The total cumulative withdrawal volume for the project shall be limited to **550,000 gallons**.
- 3. The intake of the withdrawal pipe or hose must be screened to protect aquatic life.
- Coverage under the Hydrostatic Test General Permit must be received from MDEQ's Office of Pollution Control prior to withdrawing water for the project.
- 5. This authorization shall expire on October 31, 2024.
