Dear Mr. Matheny,

On behalf of DDD Construction & Sales, LLC, FC&E Engineering (FC&E) is hereby submitting a Notice of Intent (NOI), Notice of Exemption (NOE), and associated Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) for coverage under the Mining Storm Water General Permit. The proposed mining location is located approximately 2000ft south of the intersection of Ballground Rd and MS State Hwy 3 in Redwood, MS 39156.

Upon issuance of coverage under the State's General Mining Permit, DDD Construction is requesting authorization to begin operations in mining base fill material in support of a civil construction project. The project has been funded, and authorized by both the State of Mississippi, and the United States Federal Government as a Local Public Authority project. It is recorded as Ballground #1, ER-0401-00(033)LPA/108494-702000 with the Mississippi Department of Transportation.

The proposed operation will produce approximately 7 thousand cubic yards of base fill material to satisfy design requirements of the Ballground Road #1 project. The proposed acreage of the mining operation is less than 4 acres, and is exempted from Notice of Intent to Mine Class I or II materials. The attached SWPPP shows all required measures deemed necessary to prevent any silt from leaving the mine site.

File at least 30 days prior to the commencement of mining; 15 days if a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is already on file and mine dewatering is not proposed. Lateral expansion of an existing mine that has general permit coverage requires the submittal of the Major Modification Form, not a new MNOI. However, modification of the existing SWPPP to include the expansion is required. Discharge of storm water or impounded water associated with mining or the operation of a wastewater recirculation system with no discharge without written notification of coverage from MDEQ is a violation of State Law.

If the company seeking coverage is a corporation, a limited liability company, a partnership, or a business trust, attach proof of its registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State and/or its Certificate of Good Standing. This registration or Certificate of Good Standing must be dated within twelve (12) months of the date of the submittal of this coverage form. Coverage will be issued in the company name as it is registered with the Mississippi Secretary of State.
