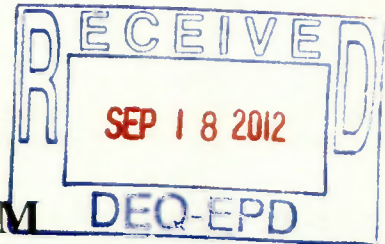

MINING STORM WATER, DEWATERING AND NO DISCHARGE GENERAL PERMIT

GENERAL PERMIT: MSR32 0024. This coverage number must be completed for the referenced mining activity or this form will be considered incomplete and will be returned. The coverage number can be found at the bottom left corner of your previous Certificate of Coverage.

The submittal of this form is required to receive coverage under the reissued Mining Storm Water, Dewatering and No Discharge General Permit. This form must be completed and returned to MDEQ at the address printed at the bottom of this form within 30 days of the date of the Letter of Instruction for Re-Coverage.

The appropriate section of this form must be completed if the applicant proposes to operate a wastewater recirculation system with no discharge and/or discharge impounded mine water (dewatering).

MDEQ will then terminate the existing "No Discharge" State Operating Permit and will extend coverage to these operations for an additional five years (until 2017) under the Mining Storm Water, Dewatering and No Discharge General Permit. Facilities discharging mine dewatering under a valid National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit can follow the same procedure to request coverage under the Mining Storm Water, Dewatering and No Discharge General Permit.
