### AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and View, Inc., Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated September 27, 2021, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following civil penalty violations that were discovered on July 27, 2021, during a Compliance Evaluation Inspection at Respondent's production facility (the Facility) located at 12380 Kirk Road, Olive Branch, Mississippi in DeSoto County:

- A. Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-29 (2)(b): Respondent discharged stormwater prior to obtaining coverage under Mississippi's Industrial Storm Water General Permit for Industrial Activities (the Permit) from the time the facility began operations to the time the Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board issued Coverage No. MSR002419 on February 1, 2021.
- B. Industrial Storm Water General Permit for Industrial Activities ACT5 T-3(4):
  Respondent failed to maintain monthly spill and leak logs.
- C. Industrial Storm Water General Permit for Industrial Activities ACT10 R-1:

AI ID 58105 ENF20230001 Respondent failed to maintain Clear Jar Tests.

D. Industrial Storm Water General Permit for Industrial Activities ACT9 S-1(4):
Respondent failed to label two Stormwater Outfalls.

E. Industrial Storm Water General Permit for Industrial Activities ACT9 S-1(1): Respondent failed to implement the SWPPP, by failing to install wattles in stormwater outfalls and failing to maintain good housekeeping.

F. Industrial Storm Water General Permit for Industrial Activities ACT5 T-7(5)(F): Respondent failed to provide secondary containment for chemical storage containers.

By letters dated October 14, 2021, and November 19, 2021, Respondent asserted that the violations listed above had been corrected and it was operating in compliance with the Permit.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$12,000.00. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations. The terms of this Agreed Order relate to conduct allegedly occurring on or before September 27, 2021.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
