This delegation authority is intended to apply to the fullest extent that such delegation authority is allowed by applicable laws and regulations.

Management positions that are responsible for the overall operation of their respective facilities are hereby delegated as having signatory authority for environmental permit applications, registrations, certifications, compliance reports and other environmental documents or submittals required or requested by the regulatory agencies, as allowed by applicable federal, state and/or local regulations.

These designated managerial positions are the Vice President — Manufacturing, Director — Manufacturing, Plant Director, Plant Manager, and persons acting in the position of Plant Manager.

The person who is designated Environmental Manager or the equivalent at the above facilities is hereby delegated signatory authority for all environmental submittals to the extent that the applicable permits and regulations allow the individual responsible for the overall operation to delegate (e.g., this generally won't be allowable for Title V submittals).
