Purpose of Inspection

This Construction Storm Water Compliance Evaluation Inspection (CEI) was conducted to determine a compliance status for Hancock Estates with the Mississippi Large Construction Storm Water General Permit Coverage, No. MSR107917.

Permit Status

The Mississippi's Large Construction Storm Water General Permit, Certificate of Coverage, No. MSR107917 was issued on March 26, 2019 and expires December 31, 2021. Provias Construction, LLC is listed as the Prime Contractor.

Facility Description

This site is located on Ida Street, Tupelo, Lee County, MS. The project is for construction of a residential development. The total acreage disturbed will be 8.5 acres. The receiving stream is Kings Creek, which is not on the Mississippi 2020 Section 303(d) List of Impaired Water Bodies. On the day of the inspection, the weather was clear with no precipitation.

Inspection Summary

MDEQ staff arrived to the site on 08/26/2021 at 10:45 A.M. (Fig. 13). Upon arrival, the site appeared to be stabilized except for two empty lots on either end of Ida Street. (Fig. 2,3,11,12). These lots were partially grassed, and at the time of inspection, there was no apparent sediment discharge off of the site.

Conclusions

Following the Construction Storm Water CEI conducted on 08/26/2021, no violations were found. It appears all construction activity has ceased on site; Hancock Estates

should continue stabilization efforts and submit a completed Request for Termination (RFT) form to terminate permit coverage.
